We will have a great time re-enacting stories and taking on character roles with our friends.		We will settle back into school life after our lovely Christmas break and re- establish ourselves with routine and behaviour expectations. We will continue regulating our emotions and feel comfortable to talk to others about how we are feeling. We will also learn to develop empathy for our friends and understand how they may be feeling based on their facial expressions, actions and words. We will develop our confidence each and every day as we engage in conversations with others and take on roles and responsibilities in our classroom. We will continue to grow in confidence as we try new activities and talk about our likes/dislikes and why. We will engage in weekly <b>HeartSmart</b> lessons that get us thinking about right and wrong and feelings and emotions. Through daily collective worship we will take time to reflect on our thoughts and feelings and experience mindfulness to develop our sense of calm and happiness.		We will continue to develop our physical skills each and every day through a range of activities. Twice a week will we take part in PE lessons, following the PE scheme <b>GetSet4PE</b> . We will engage in daily fine motor skills activities such as; scissor cutting, tweezers, threading, drawing, colouring, painting, writing and many more exciting challenges! We will develop our spatial awareness and gross motor skills during PE and outside in our Reception Class garden.
