We are excited to invite you to attend a Mastering Number Parent Project workshop with your child in January. The Mastering Number program, developed by the National Centre for Excellence in the Teaching of Mathematics (NCETM), aims to secure strong foundations in the development of good number sense for children from Reception through to Year 1 and Year 2. Our goal is to ensure that students leave Key Stage 1 with fluency in calculation, as well as confidence and flexibility with numbers.

As part of the project, you and your child will engage in three mathematical activities each week over a 5-week period, which practice key skills taught in school. This workshop is an excellent opportunity for you to engage with your child's mathematical journey, gain a greater understanding how maths is taught at our school, and discover ways to support your child's learning at home.
